## GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>Village Services:</u> You must complete a Village Services Application as a new resident. Auto-pay is available for your monthly refuse bill and debits your monthly bill amount from your checking account. To sign up for Auto-pay complete an Auto-Pay application and attach a voided check.

<u>Tenant/Renter:</u> If renting a property in the Village you must sign-up for Village Services <u>in person</u> with a valid photo ID and lease as required by the Federal Trade Commission "Red Flag Rules". The FTC created this program as an identity Theft Prevention Program.

<u>Village Services (Refuse)</u>: Village Services Bills are mailed out the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month with payment due on the 20<sup>th</sup> of every month. The Village of Glen Ellyn is pleased to offer a paperless option for your Village Services Bill. You will receive an email alert when your bill is ready to login and view. It's easy, secure and takes just a few minutes to fill out the <u>Email Authorization Form</u>. Customers registered for paperless billing will no longer receive a paper copy of their Village Services Bill through the mail. Participation in the paperless bill is voluntary. Those who do not register will continue to receive a paper copy of their Village Services bill through the mail.

What information do I need to enroll?

- A copy of your paper bill.
- · An Email address.
- A computer with internet access.

**Sprinkler Regulations:** Odd address/odd days, Even address/even days. Hours are 5-8AM and 7-11PM. (Ordinance.7-10-26)

<u>Commuter Parking</u>: The Village of Glen Ellyn offers commuter and merchant permit parking. The current wait is three (3) years for the first available permit parking space. Spaces become available only after a current permit holder forfeits their permit. If you are interested in permit parking please fill out the Parking Wait List Application which can be found on the Village website.

<u>Vehicle Stickers</u>: Any vehicle registered to a Village address must display a current Village sticker. Stickers are required regardless of where the vehicle is physically located. This includes, but is not limited to vehicles with a student away at college. New residents are given 30 days to acquire and display a current Village sticker. Vehicles registered to a Glen Ellyn address without a current Village sticker may be issued a ticket of \$50.00.

<u>Vehicle Plate Registration:</u> Secretary of State of Illinois requires you to notify them of any change in your address within 10 days. Listed below are the closest facilities and their hours.

# GARBAGE (REFUSE) AND RECYCLING SERVICES

The Village contracts with Groot Industries for refuse and recycling. Refuse carts are available in three sizes 35, 65 and 95 gallon. Recycling carts are available in two sizes 35 and 65 gallon; residents are initially given a 65 gallon cart. Both carts are provided by the Village at no charge to the resident however there is a \$16.50 delivery fee to exchange the size of either your refuse or recycling cart. This fee is waived once for new residents.

Refuse and recycling pick up is every Monday. Refuse and recycling carts may be put out no earlier than 6pm on Sunday evenings and no later than 6am on Monday mornings. Refuse that does not fit in the cart provided can be placed at the curb with a refuse sticker; stickers are available for purchase at the Cashier's Office, local grocery and hardware stores. If your refuse does not get picked up, call Groot Industries (847)429-7370 to inform them before 11:00am Tuesday to ensure that your refuse gets picked up that week.

Yard Waste is also picked up every Monday from April through November. Yard Waste is categorized as grass clippings, leafs and plant material. Yard Waste must be disposed of in either a Yard Waste paper bag or a plastic container. Both need to have a Yard Waste sticker affixed to be picked up. Stickers are available for purchase at the Cashier's office, local grocery and hardware stores.

Branch and brush service is also available in the Village May thru October. See below chart

## DISPOSING OF HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household hazardous waste (HHW) can be disposed of year round at the Regional Household Hazardous Facility, 180 Fort Hill Drive, Naperville, IL; Saturday and Sunday, 9am-2pm (except holidays). This site does not accept latex paint or electronics. However, the Village waste hauler (Groot Industries) will pick up latex paint with your regular refuse pickup if it is <u>dried or has been solidified with sand, sawdust or kitty litter; remove the paint can lid prior to disposal</u>.

The Village now offers curbside collection of bulk electronics or E-Waste. Residents must call Groot Industries at (847) 429-7370 by 5:00 pm the Friday before the regular Monday refuse pickup in order to schedule an E-Waste pickup. The correct amount of either Refuse or E-Waste Stickers must be used. Some examples of E-Waste include:

Computers Fax machines

Televisions/Monitors Video game consoles

Printers Cable boxes

Keyboards DVD/Blu-Ray players

## PERMANENT DROP BOX FOR UNWANTED MEDICATIONS

The Glen Ellyn Police Department recently partnered with the DuPage County Health Department's RxBox program to place a drug disposal box in the lobby of the Glen Ellyn Police Department located at 65 S. Park Boulevard. The box was provided by <u>SCARCE</u> through a grant from the <u>DuPage Foundation</u>. Drug disposal boxes provide safe collection and disposal of drugs as another means of minimizing the cycle of prescription drug abuse and addiction. Additionally, the proper disposal of prescription medications is environmentally friendly as it prevents medications from entering the water supply via tossing them in the trash or flushing them down the toilet.

# Internet Purchase Safe Zone

The Glen Ellyn Police Department invites the public to utilize the department's main parking lot at 65 S. Park Boulevard for internet sales. Look for the blue sign at the southwest side of the parking lot. The lot is under twenty-four hour video surveillance and police intervention, documentation or witnessing to a transaction will not be available. Residents must note that police cannot use the State computer system to run model numbers, serial numbers, etc. of items that are part of a private exchange.

Recommended tips for a safe and successful transaction:

- Clarify all details, including a description of who will attend and the type of vehicle used.
- Conduct the transaction during daylight hours.
- Bring a friend or family member.
- If they hesitate to meet at the police department that is a hint to end the deal.
- Keep a safe distance from the other person and never get in their vehicle.

If you feel uncomfortable about any aspect of the transaction, trust your instincts and move on.
