

## ROOFING PROJECT NEWS

As of November 15

Woo hoo!! **All building on Creekside have new roofs!** The gutter crew is working on 950-960 Creekside today, and should move on to 953-943 Creekside early next week. Then Creekside will be completely done!

The roofing crew started on 967-957 Tanager yesterday, and will continue working on that building through the end of the week. They will then move on to 955-945 Tanager, probably Monday, November 20.

**With the Thanksgiving holiday next week, the roofing crew is planning on working Friday, November 24 and Saturday, November 25.** On Friday, the crew will start around 6:30 – 7:00 am and work until dark, around 5 – 5:30 pm. On Saturday, the crew will start around 8:00 am and work until dark. Please make sure to move all vehicles before they show up.

You may notice your gutters in the front of your unit. The downspouts will now run above the meter. Because they no longer fit behind the meter.



Please be aware of new parking restrictions, as these are changing every few days in conjunction with the progress of the work. Overnight street parking will be allowed on Creekside and Tanager for those units whose buildings are being worked on. Once all construction is completed on your street, overnight street parking rules will return.

The roofer is doing his best to keep the Board up-to-date as conditions and circumstances change, for the better or not. We're passing on that information to all of you as quickly as we can, and will continue to adjust as needed.

Here are the key items to keep things going smoothly and safely

- Please move your cars from all driveways and areas marked in red **before 6:30 AM**. Vehicles impeding the construction crew will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Please be respectful of your neighbors driveways and vehicles during the construction. Driveways should not be blocked by residents or their guests.
- Take down security cameras when construction begins on your building so they are not accidentally damaged. They can be put back up once all work is completed for your building.
- Do no cross cones and barriers as it is not safe for you or the workers. Nails may be present on the driveways when the cones are up.
- On Mondays, garbage pickup days, please move your bins outside of the red and yellow zones.
- If you lease your unit, please make sure to share this information with your tenant.

Frequent updates will be provided as the project progresses. The roofer is putting notices on garages, usually the day before he begins working on a building.
